


All FaithWeaver NOW resources—for infants through adults—explore the same Bible passage each week, making it easier for you to help your family grow in faith together.

Bags packed and ready to go? We meet the Israelites as they are FINALIY leaving Egypt after being slaves for hundreds of years! God guided them with a cloud by day and with fire by night. But THEN God guided them to the edge of the Red Sea. And quess who the Israelites saw when they turned around? Yup! Those stubborn Egyptians headed straight toward them — with swords drawn! Would YOU be afraid? The Israelites sure were,

- so Moses called out to God. And God split the Red Sea, and everyone passed
  - through the middle. Well, not EVERYONE. God gave those pesky Egyptians
  - an advanced course in swimming. (They didn't pass.)
  - Describe some trips that you've been on as a family.
  - Tell about a time you were afraid. How did you overcome your fear?

TURN OFF THE LIGHTS IN YOUR HOUSE (EXCEPT FOR ONE DIM LIGHT IN A CENTRAL LOCATION-SUCH AS THE LIGHT OVER YOUR STOVE). PLAY HIDE-AND-SEEK IN THE DARK AS A FAMILY. AFTER A FEW ROUNDS, DISCUSS WHAT IT WAS LIKE TO HIDE AND BE FOUND IN THE DARK. WHY WAS THIS GAME DIF-FERENT IN THE DARK? WITH THE LIGHTS STILL OFF, PRAY TOGETHER, THANKING GOD FOR BEING WITH YOU WHEN YOU'RE AFRAID.

WEEK 5	God Gives the Ten Commandments (Part 2) (Exodus 19:16–20:21)	" 'Do not murder, do not commit adultery, do not steal, do not give false testimony, honor your father and mother,' and 'love your neighbor as yourself' " (Matthew 19:18-19).	God tells us how to respect others.
WEEK 6	The Israelites Worship a Golden Calf (Exodus 32:1-25)	"I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. You shall have no other gods before me" (Exodus 20:2-3).	Only God deserves our worship.
WEEK 7	The Israelites Build the Tabernacle (Exodus 35:4–36:38)	"And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him" (Colossians 3:17).	We all can serve God.
WEEK 8	Moses Sends Spies Into the Promised Land (Numbers 13:1-14:23)	"Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain" (1 Corinthians 15:58).	Be brave for God.
WEEK 9	Balaam's Donkey Talks (Numbers 22:1-38)	"Come and see what God has done, how awesome his works in man's behalf!" (Psalm 66:5).	Pay attention to God.
WEEK 10	Joshua Becomes Leader of Israel (Joshua 1:1-11)	"Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go" (Joshua 1:9).	God is with us.
WEEK 11	Joshua Sends Spies to Jericho (Joshua 2:1-24)	"And without faith it is impossible to please God" (Hebrews 11:6).	We can have faith that God will do big things in our lives.
WEEK 12	The Israelites Cross the Jordan River (Joshua 3:1–4:24)	"Give thanks to the Lord, call on his name; make known among the nations what he has done" (1 Chronicles 16:8).	Remember what God has done.
