

#### Shine

Dim the room lights, and let your baby play with a small, pen-sized flashlight. Help your baby point the beam of light around the room.

#### Homage

Say: Lots of people brought Jesus gifts. We can bring Jesus gifts, too.

Encourage your child to find a prized toy or stuffed animal. Then have your child follow as you march around the room. Then stop and have your child set down the prized item. Say: We can bring our qifts to Jesus.



#### Wide-Eyed Wonder

As young children watch their parents and other adults, they may feel that adults can do anything. As children mature they will lose this sense of awe. However, we can increase a child's sense of wonder at what Jesus does by communicating admiration and enthusiasm as we tell Bible stories about Jesus.

#### Help your child become a FaithWeaver with these ideas:

- Take your child along as you donate items such as food, money, or clothing. Tell your child that sharing what we have is just like giving Jesus gifts.
- Let your child pretend to be the "king of the house." Make a simple crown for him or her to wear. Explain that Jesus is our king who does great things.
