

Fall Quarter Introduction



The Israelites Cross the Red Sea Exodus 13:17–14:31

Voung children are just becoming aware of their feelings. They need help finding the language to describe their emotions. When you recognize a feeling that a child is experiencing, name it. You might say, "I see that Josh is feeling happy!" or "Oh, Katie! I see you're feeling sad." Help children look to God by turning these acknowledgments into prayers. For example, you could pray, "Thank you, God, for Josh's happy feelings" or "Dear God, help Katie as she's feeling sad." By doing this, you're helping them learn to express their feelings to God as they grow in their relationship with him.

Exodus 13:17-14:31



BIBLE BACKGROUND FOR LEADERS

God Cares for His People

As the mass of more than 2 million Hebrews left Egypt, God knew that facing the warlike Philistines immediately would likely have made the Hebrews lose hope and turn back to Egypt. The pillar of cloud by day and pillar of fire by night must have been awesome and comforting.

God's Unusual Strategy

God instructed the Israelites to turn back somewhat toward Egypt and camp at a spot between Migdol and the Red Sea. God had a bigger plan than anyone else could know. Pharaoh would've been confident that he could easily defeat the Israelites.

The Israelites were slaves of the Egyptians only days prior to this event. They'd been beaten by the whips of the slave drivers and were familiar with the weapons the Egyptians carried. They must've realized that their fighting talents were nothing compared with the Egyptians'. And they were backed against the sea, with mountains on two sides and the Egyptians bearing down on them. The situation must've seemed hopeless.

God Shows His Power

We can realize that God had all this planned. He knew that the people would be frightened. He knew that they would doubt him. But he also knew that his power would be remembered forever. God knew that he would prevail, that the Hebrews would be saved from Pharaoh, and that the result would be a people growing greatly in their faith in him.

It may seem odd that no record of this event has been found in Egyptian history. However, it's likely that all records were wiped from the books because it would've been an embarrassment for the world to know that mighty Egypt had been devastated by its own lowly slaves.

The Jesus Connection

We live in troubled times when it's easy for people to lose heart and feel hopeless and lost. But a relationship with Jesus can give us peace and joy. Jesus is our light in dark times.

When have you felt out of sorts and desperate to find some control over your situation? Perhaps the Israelites felt these things after they escaped from Egypt. Although they may not have recognized it at the time, eventually they were able to look back and see how God used that time to protect them and bring glory to himself.

What part of your life might God have his hand in

now? What can you do to connect with God during times of fear and desperation? Take a few minutes to reflect on God's hand in your life. Write your reflection here.

Insert the Moses puppet through the slit in the picture. Encourage baby to touch the Moses puppet as you move it. God helped Moses when he was afraid.

Drops of Water

What You'll Do

Spray some drops of water on the tablecloth. Encourage your crawlers to explore the drops of water. Hold your non-crawlers, and help them explore the drops of water.

Say: Moses and his people couldn't get across the water. They were afraid. But God helped them. ▶ GOD HELPS US WHEN WE'RE AFRAID.



Hidden Moses

What You'll Do

Set a baby on the floor near you.

Say: Where's Moses? Pause. He's under the blanket. Is he afraid under there? Pause. Then lift the blanket, and peek at Moses. Have Moses say, "I was afraid, but God helped me."

Put the blanket over baby's head. Say: [Baby's name], are you afraid under there? God is always with us, and ▶GOD HELPS US WHEN WE'RE AFRAID. Sneak the Moses puppet under the blanket, and say: Brave Moses! Brave baby! ▶GOD HELPS US WHEN WE'RE AFRAID.

Running From Egypt

What You'll Do

Sit on the floor with one or two toddlers. Open your Bible to Exodus 13, and show toddlers the words. Tell them the Bible is God's special book. Hold up the Moses puppet.

Say: The Bible tells about a man named Moses. Moses and his people were running away from Egypt. Let's make the sound of people running. Show toddlers how to pat their hands on their legs. Moses and his people ran until they came to some water. Splish, splash, splash. Show toddlers how to slap the floor with open hands. The people were afraid. They didn't know how to get across the water. But we know that

GOD HELPS US WHEN WE'RE AFRAID.

Show toddlers the teaching picture. Put the Moses puppet through the slit, and make him walk on dry land.

Say: God made some dry land to walk on. Listen to the sound of the dry sand. Rub your palms together, encouraging the toddlers to copy the motion. Off Moses and his friends went. Hooray! They walked to the other side. Then the water filled the sea again. Clap your hands together. God helped the people when they were afraid.

• GOD HELPS US WHEN WE'RE AFRAID, too. Thank you, God!





Flee Through the Sea

What You'll Do

Set one or two toddlers next to the blanket tunnel. Say: **Moses and his people had to go from one place to another really fast.** Encourage children to see how quickly they can crawl through the tunnel. Some may not like the dark inside the tunnel and may resist crawling through.

Say: God helped Moses when he was afraid. ► GOD HELPS US WHEN WE'RE AFRAID, too.

Give each child a big hug when he or she makes it through the tunnel. Many children will want to repeat this experience several times.

In God's Hands

What You'll Do

Have everyone sit on the floor, and enjoy this finger play with toddlers. Encourage toddlers to repeat the motions after you.

Say: Many, many Israelites tromping through the sand, (rock from side to side, and slap your palms against the floor as you go from one side to the other)

One stepped out and touched wet land. Splash! (bring arms to chest; then push arms out on the word "splash")

EXPLORATION

Through the Water

What You'll Do

Lay the "Israelites Cross the Red Sea" poster on the floor, and let children look at it while you tell about the Israelites crossing the Red Sea.

Open your Bible to Exodus 13, and show children the words. Tell them the Bible is God's special book. Say: **Show me what you do when you're afraid.** Let the twos share. **Show me your scared face.** Pause.

Say: There was a man named Moses who was the leader of God's people. Point out Moses on the poster. The Israelites were running away from Egypt. Let's stand up and run in place. Lift your legs and run fast! Continue telling what happened as twos run in place. The Israelites came to some water. Then they stopped. After twos have run in place for about 30 seconds, spray some water in the air above them, letting it fall on them. Encourage them to stop when they feel the water. Then point to the waves in the poster. The waves were big. There was too much water to walk through. There was too much water to swim across. Allow each child to spray water on the Israelites in the poster. The Israelites didn't know what to do. They were afraid.

Let's pretend that you're the Israelites. I'll be Moses. Follow me wherever I go. March around the room. Encourage the children to follow you. Lead them back to where

you started. Then point out Moses on the poster, and say: God led Moses, and Moses led his people, just as I led you. God knew the people were afraid, so God helped them. He made dry land for them to walk on, while the water stood high all around them. Walk around the group of children, spraying the water bottle away from them. God helped the people stay safe. God helped the Israelites when they were afraid. ► GOD HELPS US WHEN WE'RE AFRAID, too.

Red Sea Walk

What You'll Do

Form two groups of 2-year-olds. One group will be the Israelites; the other will be the Red Sea. Have the Red Sea group stand in two lines facing each other. Give the children in the Red Sea group each a crepe paper streamer to hold up high and shake while the Israelites are walking through.

Sing "Red Sea Walk" to the tune of "Ring Around the Rosie" while children are walking through the "Red Sea." Have the Red Sea group fall down after the "Israelites" have walked through. If necessary, sing the song twice to give time for all the Israelites to walk through the "Red Sea."

Walking through the Red Sea,

The Israelites are home free! Splashes, splashes,

The sea falls down!

Have the groups change roles, and do the activity and song again.

Afterward, say: God helped the Israelites when they were afraid. ▶ GOD HELPS US WHEN WE'RE AFRAID, too.

Fear Prayers

What You'll Do

Have your 2-year-olds sit near you.

Say: I was afraid of [name something you were afraid of], but God helped me. > GOD HELPS US WHEN WE'RE AFRAID.

Ask:

What are some things you're afraid of?

Pray with children about their fears. Children this age are relatively new to praying aloud in a group. You may need to word the prayers for them. For example, you could say, "God, Susie is afraid when her mom leaves her at preschool. Please help her not be afraid." Then say to the child, "You can pray, too. Say, 'I'm afraid; please help me.' " Allow time for the child to pray.

After all the children have had an opportunity to pray with you, give each a copy of the "Moses Crosses the Red Sea" page. Squirt about a nickel-sized dot of glue on the dry land part of each child's handout, and show children how to use cotton swabs to spread the glue on the path through the parted Red Sea. Have children sprinkle glitter onto the glue to help them remember the dry land the Israelites walked on.

Say: The Israelites were afraid when they couldn't get across the water. God helped the Israelites by giving them dry land. ▶ GOD HELPS US WHEN WE'RE AFRAID, too.

Growing With Jesus



Dealing With Your Child's Fears

A newborn's response to a loud noise or sudden shift in position is known as the startle reflex. While pediatricians tell us it's simply a reflex response, sometime between their fourth and sixth months, many children begin to develop specific fears. Depending on the child, he or she will deal with these fears differently, but you can help. In addition to praying with your child, show your child how to handle the thing that's causing him or her to be afraid. For example, if your child is afraid of a family pet, talk through the steps you take in approaching the animal.



Your child learned God helps us when we're afraid (from Exodus 13:17–14:31). Your child participated in one of the following activities today. You can use these activities with your child to help your child grow with Jesus throughout the week.

INFANT

Drops of Water

Lay a plastic tablecloth on the floor. Spray some drops of water onto the tablecloth, and encourage your child to explore the drops of water.

Say: Moses and his people couldn't get across the water. They were afraid. But God helped them. God helps us when we're afraid, too.

TODDLER

Drape a blanket over two chairs to create a tunnel for your toddler to crawl through. Tell your child that Moses and his people had to go from one place to another really fast. Encourage your child to see how quickly he or she can crawl through the tunnel.

Say: God helped Moses when he was afraid. God helps us when we're afraid, too.

Fear Prayers

Sit down with your child.
Say: I was afraid of [name something you were afraid of], but God helped me.
God helps us when we're afraid. Ask your child about things he or she is afraid of.

Pray for your child about his or her fears. Then say to your child: You can pray, too. Say, "I'm afraid; please help me." Allow time for your child to pray.

Say: The Israelites were afraid when they couldn't get across the water. God helped the Israelites by giving them dry land. God helps us when we're afraid, too.

Use these ideas to help your child become a FaithWeaver:

- While your child is taking a bath, tell about Moses crossing the Red Sea and how God helped Moses when Moses was afraid. Have your child try to separate the water, and talk about the miracle God performed that day.
- Play a game of Hide-and-Seek. When your child comes near your hiding place, jump out and say, "Hey, you!" After a good laugh, tell your child that you're proud of how brave he or she is becoming with God's help.


