What You’ll Do

Set a baby 6 months or older on your lap, and show the child the “Elisha and the Widow” teaching picture.

Say: **The woman didn’t have any food for herself and her boys. They were poor and hungry. God sent a special person named Elisha to help the woman get food for her family.** Place some O-shaped cereal pieces in your hand. Attempt to feed one piece of cereal to the baby. If the baby enjoys the cereal, you may feed him or her more, one piece at a time. (Check with parents before feeding their child.)

Say: **God took care of the poor woman.** ► **GOD CARES FOR US.**

Without bread to eat, (*hold baby's hands up to his or her mouth*)

Her days would be through.

God sent a man— (*walk your fingers up the baby's arm*)

He knew what to do. (*place the baby's hands on his or her head*)

He started with a little oil, and it grew and grew! (*stretch the baby's arms out wide*)

The woman took the oil and went to buy some bread—

The woman ate and ate; so happy she was fed. (*rub the baby's tummy*)



Gather some toddlers around you. Open your Bible to 2 Kings 4, and show children the words. Tell them the Bible is God's special book. Show children the "Elisha and the Widow" teaching picture.

Say: **The woman and her sons didn't have any food. All they had was a little bit of oil. They were very hungry. Have children rub their bellies and pretend to be hungry. God sent a special man named Elisha to help them. Elisha had the woman pour the oil into many pots and pans. God turned the little bit of oil into lots of oil. Then the woman sold the oil and bought food, and everyone ate. They were so happy.** Give each child a graham cracker to eat. **God took care of the woman and her sons and made sure they had enough food to eat. ► GOD CARES FOR US.**

Give each child a "The Widow's Oil" page. Set shallow bowls of vegetable oil and cotton swabs on the table. Show the children how to dip the cotton swabs into the oil and paint the pictures on their papers.


Say: **Look at the pretty patterns you're making with oil. God used oil to help the woman buy food. ► GOD CARES FOR US.**

Give each child a pot or pan and a kitchen utensil. Play "He Cares for You" (1 Peter 5:7) (track 2 on the CD). Encourage toddlers bang on their pots and pans while the music plays.





What You'll Do

Set out several pots and pans, and have children gather in a circle. Open your Bible to 2 Kings 4, and show kids the words. Tell children the Bible is God’s special book. Then show them the “Elisha and the Widow” teaching picture.

Say: **The woman didn’t have food for her sons and herself. All she had was a little oil.** Pass a small bottle of vegetable oil around the circle. **The woman did not know what to do. God sent a special man named Elisha to help her. Elisha told the woman to pour her oil into many jars.** Help the children take turns pouring a little oil into a few pots and pans. Let the children touch the oil to see how it feels. Provide wet wipes for children to clean their fingers.


Say: **A special thing happened. The woman had only a little oil. But as she poured the oil, it turned into a lot of oil and filled all of the pots and pans the woman could**

What You'll Do ■■■■■■

Place the tissue paper on a table or craft area. Pour glue into plastic dishes or on lids. Help kids put on paint shirts or smocks. If you don't have those, keep wet wipes handy to wipe off any messes.

Say: **The woman in the Bible had a jar of oil. God turned a little bit of oil into a whole lot! Let's make our own oil jars to remind us that ► GOD CARES FOR US.**

Show children how to smear glue onto the plastic cups and then cover the cups with the colored tissue paper. Set aside the "jars" to dry, and help kids wash their hands.

To Market, to Market

What You'll Do ■■■■■■


Arrange towels on the floor to protect it, or take this activity outside. Set a plastic container filled with water on one side of the room and an empty plastic container about 10 feet away.

Have the children line up behind the container filled with water, and give each child a plastic cup.

Say: **After God turned the woman's little bit of oil into a lot of oil, the woman took the oil to sell it. Let's pretend that this water is oil. Let's help the woman take her oil to the store so she can sell it and buy food.**

Have one child fill a cup with water, walk to the other container, pour the water into it, and say ► **GOD CARES FOR US.** When the first child returns, have another child repeat the process, and so on. Ensure each child has a turn.


Say: **You did it! Now the woman can buy food for her family. ► GOD CARES FOR US. Hooray!**

Growing With Jesus



Nice Serve!

One of the most powerful memories you can give your child is doing a service project as a family. Develop traditions of caring for people in need. Take your child with you to visit a person who's housebound. Make an annual tradition of helping your child choose food to donate. The lifestyle of servanthood you model for your child will last a lifetime.

Your child learned that God cares for us (from 2 Kings 4:1-7). Your child participated in one of the following activities today. You can use these activities with your child to help your child grow with Jesus throughout the week.

INFANT

Smooth Oil

Set your baby on the floor next to you. Gently rub baby oil onto your baby's hand.

Say: **Oil feels good when we rub it on our skin. I'm taking care of you by rubbing oil on your hand. God gave the woman lots and lots of oil so she could sell it and buy food to eat. God cares for us.**

TODDLER

Drum Roll

Say: **Let's sing a song to celebrate that God cares for us. The woman poured the oil God gave her into pots and pans, so we're going to bang on pots and pans while we sing a song.**

Give your child a pot or pan and a kitchen utensil. Play a recorded praise song, or sing one such as "Jesus Loves Me" with your child. Encourage your child to sing and bang on the pots and pans.

2-YEAR-OLD

Joyous Jars

Cut colored tissue paper or construction paper into 1-inch squares. Draw a simple jar shape on paper, and set out a glue stick or bottle of washable glue.

Say: **The woman had a jar of oil. God turned a little bit of oil into a whole lot! Let's make our own oil jar to remind us that God cares for us.**


Help your child glue the paper pieces onto the jar shape. Set aside the "jar" to dry.


