

The average 5-year-old has a vocabulary of **above 2,000 words,** so kids can understand and use many adjectives to describe Jesus' works. The Bible Point for this week's lesson is "Jesus does great things." Have your child practice his or her verbal skills by replacing the word *great* with another adjective, such as awesome or cool. Isn't it great what kids can do at this age?





Remind your child that King Solomon told about the great things Jesus would do. Tell your child that when we have an important announcement to make, we want everyone to hear. Let your child make an edible megaphone by wrapping pressed fruit strips around a sugar cone. Use water to wet the ends of the fruit strips so that the stickiness helps secure the strips in place. Have your child

bite off the tip of the cone and speak into the "megaphone" to make an important announcement about Jesus. Then eat and enjoy!

- **ASK** @ What important thing could you say about Jesus?
 - Who would you want to tell?



This week, your child learned that Jesus does great things. He or she committed to one of the following challenges to recognize the great things that Jesus does in daily life. Help your child weave faith into life this week and follow through on the challenge!



- Tell a friend about one of the great things Jesus does that you heard about from the Bible today.
- Ask your mom or dad or another adult to read from the Bible about a great thing Jesus has done.
- Make a card for Jesus and thank him for a wonderful thing that he has done in your life.



Sing this song with your child to the tune of "The Farmer in the Dell." After singing the song once, have your child change the line "My Jesus does great things" to something wonderful that Jesus does, such as "My Jesus heals the sick."

What I Learned Today ...

Bible Time: This week's Scripture (Psalm 72:1-19) tells us that Jesus does great things. Long before Jesus' birth, Solomon told of the great things Jesus would do. Your child learned that Jesus can bring justice, comfort the hurting, and save the needy. Jesus will live forever, and all nations will be blessed through him. Jesus does such great things now and forever!

Key Verse: Jesus is the way to God (adapted from John 14:6).
