Worship Session 1

Super Pup's Fan Club

Bible Story: Jesus Teaches About Commitment (Mark 8:31-38)

Worship Theme: Jesus is worthy of our commitment.

PREPARATION: None

Theo: (*Excitedly*) Oh boy, oh boy, oh boy, oh boy, oh boy!

Leader: Wow, Theo! You're sure excited today. What happened to make your tail wag so fast?

Theo: Oh, you'll never believe it! Nothing this good has ever happened to me before!

Leader: Theo, you've got to tell us what happened.

Theo: It's what came in the mail today. It came with my name on it. It said, "To Theophilus FaithRetriever." That's me!

Leader: Is that why you're so excited? Because you got mail?

Theo: It's not just any letter. It's from Super Pup himself. Super Pup wants me to be in his fan club!

Leader: That sounds neat, Theo! What happens when you're a part of the fan club?

Theo: Well, there's a really cool T-shirt that I get to wear. Plus, I'll learn the secret handshake. And Super Pup will send me important information about how to help him defend the world against the evil Crazo Cats.

Leader: That sounds like great fun, Theo. But tell me, what do you have to do to become a member of the fan club?

Theo: (*Dejectedly*) Well, that's the bad news. Super Pup says I have to send \$19.99 to be in the fan club. Plus I have to promise to get Super Pup comic books for the next 10 years. My mom says that's too big of a commitment. I don't think she's gonna let me join. When I asked her, she said she'd think about it. I know what that means. It means no.

Leader: I'm not so sure about that, but I do agree with your mom. Getting comic books for 10 years and paying \$19.99 is an awfully big commitment. Are you sure it's worth it?

Theo: Sure, I'm sure! Super Pup is way cool!

Leader: I'm sure he is, but are you sure you'll like him 10 years from now? You have to be careful when you make commitments, Theo. You have to make sure that the one you're committing yourself to is worth it.

Theo: But how do I make sure?

Leader: Well, why don't you stick around with us today. We're learning about someone who's really worthy of our commitment.

Theo: Are you talking about Super Pup today?

Leader: Not today. Today we'll talk about how Jesus is worthy of our commitment.

Theo: Is that because Jesus is strong and powerful and loving and cool and—

Leader: (*Interrupting*) Yes, Theo. That's exactly right. So do you want to learn about Jesus with us?

Theo: You bet! I'm already a member of Jesus' fan club. Super Pup may be great, but Jesus is the greatest!
