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

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Take-It-Home Flyer Tips

Follow these steps to get Take-It Home Flyers off the ground effectively so they'll cruise on a direct flight home.

- 1. Follow your Simply Loved Leader Guide. The end of each elementary lesson is strategically written to incorporate these flyers.
- 2. Read the first page to your whole group of kids first. This is meant to be a quiet prayer time that intentionally connects kids to their friend Jesus.
- 3. Next, ask the "Talk Starter" question aloud, and give time for kids to discuss and pray in Connect Crews.
- 4. THEN, *and only then*, distribute Take-It-Home Flyers to kids. If you choose to forgo this strategic order, prepare to have papers whizzing by your head before you're ready for them.
- 5. Be sure to point out the challenge on the top of the folding instructions page. That'll *really* motivate kids to make sure this page gets home.
- 6. Be sure to give each helper a copy, too—not to fold for themselves, but so kids can reference the instructions once folding begins.



Fold a flyer. When you get home __


...lay a phone on a table. See who can land the plane closest to the phone—you or a family member.

Here's how:


1 Fold the paper in half lengthwise as shown.




2 Unfold, and then fold the top two corners to the center line to create flaps.




3 Once again, fold the paper on half.



4 Fold the edges down to meet the bottom of the airplane body.




5 Take aim, and let it fly!


