# I Wonder...

Today we discovered in the Bible what God created each day, from light and seas to stars and trees!

- ❓ Sometimes I wonder...why did God make everything in that order? Did he just make whatever he wanted as he thought of it? Or was there a reason? Let's find out with a guided drawing activity.

Have everyone divide a sheet of paper into three columns and use markers to draw the following:

- In the first column, draw the sun, moon, and stars.
- In the second, draw birds on the top and fish on the bottom of the column.
- In the third, draw animals and people.

You drew things God made. But oh no! The sun, moon, and stars need a sky! And the fish need some water. And what will animals eat to stay alive? Now let's add the things God made during the first three days of creation to our drawings. We'll use crayons so we can still see our other drawings.

- In the first column, draw light and dark.
- In the second, draw the sky and sea.
- In the third, draw land.

- ❓ What surprised you about the order God made everything in?

The first things God created gave a space and place for the next things. God knew exactly what to make in the right order. How cool and creative that God knew exactly what he was doing and sprinkled our lives with such detailed and beautiful creations!

- ❓ What's your favorite beautiful thing God created?

God created the world so beautifully for us! He could've left it boring, but he added in amazing creations because **God always loves us!** (*Wow, God!*)
