And you want to share all of that with kids in your community!



Before True North



Pray for everyone who will attend True North.

Ask God to prepare your heart and the hearts of the kids and leaders who will be part of VBS.



Work with the VBS Director to collect necessary supplies.

Many supplies, like posters and the Sing & Play Peak Music CD, will likely already be in the room. Be sure to get the Juneau stickers from the Preschool Bible Packs.



Set the stage to inspire imaginations.

Understand your role.

Closing Circle allows preschoolers to stay in their own preschool-friendly play space and have a shorter time that's designed specifically for little ones who are likely wearing down from a busy day at VBS.



Choose a room for Closing Circle.

Your room should be large enough to accommodate all preschoolers. Also, this is where parents and caregivers pick up their children. You may want to use the same room as Bible Adventures & Missions so the room is already decorated.

During True North



Use an attention-getting signal.

Attention-getting signals let kids know when it's time to stop what they're doing and look at you. Use the Wilderness Whistle (available from group.com or your Group VBS supplier) or another signal of your choice.



Repeat the daily Bible Point often.

Every activity focuses on one memorable Bible truth called the Bible Point. Repeating the Bible Point helps kids remember it and apply it to their lives after VBS. Each time kids hear the day's Bible Point, they finish it by pretending to pull a rope with both hands and saying, "Trust Jesus!"



Get Crew Leaders involved!

Guide Crew Leaders to participate right along with kids. When Crew Leaders listen, get involved, and have fun, kids do too! They're a great asset in helping worn-out little ones!

What's Closing Circle?

Closing Circle is a special time *just* for preschoolers! This allows preschoolers to stay in their own preschool-friendly play space (most likely your Bible Adventures area) and have a shorter time that's designed specifically for little ones who are likely wearing down from a busy day at VBS. While the elementary kids gather for a large-group wrap-up, you'll host this preschoolsize, age-appropriate, 15-minute Closing Circle. (You'll see this idea modeled in *many* preschools as an easy way to review the day and send everyone off with a smile.) Preschoolers will review the Bible story and verse, talk about God Sightings®, participate in a prayer, sing along with the Sing & Play Peak Music DVD (so *you* don't have to learn all the motions), and get a Juneau sticker to remind them of their day at True North VBS!

If your Preschool Director decides to have preschoolers rotate through age-appropriate stations, you'll use a schedule similar to this one. (Note: Unless specifically indicated, these are *not* the same stations that elementary kids will visit.)

We can Trust Jesus!

When we wonder, we can trust Jesus.

Bible Verse: "Anyone who listens to my teaching and


follows it is wise." (Matthew 7:24)

Bible Story: John prepares the way and baptizes

Jesus. (Matthew 3; 11:1-6)

Jesus' cousin John came with unconventional clothes, a pauper's diet, and a bold message: "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is near." Meaning? Jesus the Messiah and fulfillment of God's kingdom on earth—is here! John proclaimed Jesus' power and authority. He resisted the very idea of baptizing Jesus, the one who would baptize with fire and the Holv Spirit! While John adamantly proclaimed Christ, even he had questions about Jesus. From prison, John sent a message to Jesus, asking, "Are you the Messiah we've been expecting, or should we keep looking for someone else?" John's circumstances may have caused him to wonder if (and when) Jesus might take political action. Scholars ponder if John may have assumed the Messiah would be the one to rescue God's people from Roman rule—as many Jews of the time anticipated. However, Jesus had a greater mission than anyone could comprehend. He came to save the world from sin. Such love and compassion go beyond anything we can understand or imagine!

Kids' curiosity can be intimidating—and a bit wearying. They have so many questions, many of which we simply can't answer. And when it comes to questions about Jesus, God, or the Bible, adults can really feel overwhelmed and underprepared. But we don't have to have all the answers! Sometimes our wonderings can lead to true wonder, as we discover the mystery and marvel of God. Today, celebrate curiosity and questions. Point kids to Jesus, a trustworthy and true friend who will guide us as we seek to know and understand him better.



Pointing to Jesus

People (even John the Baptist) wondered about Jesus. This passage can encourage kids that it's okay to ask questions about Jesus—he will always help us find the truth.





Before Kids Arrive...

Be sure you have all the Day 1 Bible Activity Pages from the Preschool Bible Pack that children worked on during Exploration Stations.

Hang the Day 1 Bible Story Poster near your Closing Circle area. (If you're gathering in the same place as Bible Adventures, the poster will already be there.)

Review the Bible Adventure

Gather children in one large circle; be sure Crews are sitting together.

SAY

It was so fun to explore God's amazing creation with you today! We made new friends and learned about what it means to trust Jesus!

In Bible Adventures, you heard about Jesus' friend John. Point to the Bible Story Poster. John told people that Jesus is someone special. And when John wondered about who Jesus was, Jesus helped him know that when we wonder, we can... (trust Jesus!)

Open up a Day 1 Bible Activity Page. Show the colorful Bible story picture on the other side.

Every day, you'll get to take home a Bible picture to share the story with your family! You can show your family this picture and tell them how God told everyone that Jesus was his special Son! Wow!

COMPASS CLUE

At Exploration Stations, preschoolers get the chance to do the day's Bible Activity Page from the Preschool Bible Pack. Make sure you have enough extra activity pages for every child to have one to take home, even if they chose not to do the activity at Exploration Stations. The Bible Packs also include a special daily sticker to hand out in Closing Circle to encourage kids to share what they've learned.

Review the Bible Verse

SAY


The Bible tells us that we can trust Jesus! When we listen to Jesus, he says we're wise—that means we choose to do the right thing! Let's say the words of our Bible verse and do the motions all together!

Lead children in saying Matthew 7:24 a few times while doing the actions below.



Learning the daily Bible verse's accompanying actions is part of Sticky Scripture each day, so preschoolers have already learned the motions that go along with today's verse. Make sure to review the motions with them to help the Bible-learning stick!

Explain God Sightings®

God is doing amazing things all around us—we just have to look for them. We can look at and celebrate all the cool things God made in our world. They're everywhere! God filled our world with things like good-smelling flowers, shady trees, soft grass, and cool water. When we see something God made or did, it's called a God Sighting.

ASK Call out some things that make you smile.

Give kids and leaders a minute to call out ideas.

God loves us! He puts things in our world that make us smile.

Those are God Sightings because we see God's goodness to us.

Your smiling faces make me smile!

We're going to look for God Sightings together this week. To help us remember, let's learn a special song.

Lead preschoolers in putting both hands up to their eyes, like binoculars.

They can do this motion as you sing the following song to the tune of "If You're Happy and You Know It":

Watch for God and you will see what he has done! (Clap, clap)

All his love for you and me!

Have kids sing the song a few times.

SAY I have one more thing to help you remember to look for ways God's love is all around us. This is a present for each of you!

> Hand each Crew Leader enough Watch for God Wristbands for everyone in the Crew, including the Crew Leader, to have one.

Tell children that the words on the wristband say "Watch for God."

While Crew Leaders put a wristband on each child and themselves, sing the song a few more times.

Give Juneau Stickers and Close in Prayer

SAY

I have another special gift for you. Your Crew Leader will give each of you a fun sticker with our friend Juneau the puppy on it! When you head home today, your Juneau sticker can remind you that when we wonder, we can... (trust Jesus!)

Give Crew Leaders a Juneau sticker for every child in their Crews.

Encourage them to remind each child, by name, of the Bible Point as they hand out the stickers—for example, "You can trust Jesus with all your wonderings, Ella."

When kids all have Juneau stickers, ask everyone to hold hands with the people next to them to make one large circle.

You got to explore True North, a place filled with mighty moose and growly grizzlies. In this wonderful place, we found out more about trusting Jesus. But your family and friends might not know that they can trust Jesus, too. When your friends and family see this sticker, tell them, "You can trust Jesus!" Let's talk with our friend Jesus right now. We call that praying. When we pray, sometimes we close our eyes so we're not looking at all our other friends. Let's do that now.









PRAY Jesus, we're glad you were with us today and that you go with us as we leave. We trust that you'll help us with our questions and love us no matter what. You're a true friend! In your special name we pray, amen.

Wrap Up With Music

Turn on the Sing & Play Peak Music DVD, and lead children in singing and doing the motions along with the DVD.

Lead kids in the theme song, "Let's Trust in Jesus," and invite parents and caregivers to come in.



Keep the music DVD playing as parents and caregivers get their children. Kids love the extra time to sing the fun songs, and parents love watching their preschoolers worshipping with so much joy!

Have Crew Leaders collect children's name badges and return them to the Crew bags for tomorrow.

Stand near the door to give hugs or high-fives. Be sure children take home their Bible Activity Pages and any craft items they made today.



As kids leave, remind them (and their parents) that they'll start off with the big kids in Sing & Play Peak tomorrow—and for the rest of the days of True North VBS.
